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POST-Op Intravenous Anesthesia Sedation

1. The medication which will be used for sedation, or to put you at ease, will be acting in your body for the next 24 hours. You might feel a little sleepy when you get home. This feeling should slowly wear off. **A responsible adult must accompany the patient to the office, remain in the office during the procedure, and drive the patient home. If the patient is under 18 years old a parent or legal guardian must accompany the patient.**
2. For the next 24 hours, you should not:
 - Drive a car or operate machinery
 - Drink any alcoholic drinks (not even beer)
 - Make any important decisions such as to sign important papers.
3. If your IV site becomes red, swollen and warm to touch, you should call Walton Dental Care at 770-267-2301.
4. We advise you to read the above instructions carefully and if you do not understand them, ask questions before you leave the office.
